

## **EXAMINATION RULES**

### **Attendance**

- A student is expected to attend all classes i.e. theory, practical, tutorial and industrial training
- Attendance in all cases shall be counted from the date of commencement of classes.
- Must have attended not less than 75% of aggregate of all the classes conducted
- 10% of total attendance can be condoned by the Principal on Medical Grounds
- Medical Certificate from a Registered Medical Practitioner is MUST
- Principal may condone on any other reason
- Beyond this NO other RELAXATION is available

### **Minimum Pass Marks**

#### ***Theory Subject***

- Internal Assessment + End Term Examination - 40%

#### ***Practical Subject***

- Internal Assessment + End Term Examination - 50%
- For Industrial Training, Research Project & Term Work - 50%

### **Internal Assessment**

- 20% of Semester Marks shall be Internal Assessment Marks - That is 20 marks out of 100 is internal
- Follow Kerala university instructions as given from time to time for Theory & Practical Internal / Assessment marks
- Internal Assessment marks + Semester Exam marks = Semester Marks ( 20 Marks +80 Marks =100 Marks)

#### ***Internal Mark division for Theory paper***

- 5 Marks for attendance
- 5 Marks for assignment
- 10 marks for internal exam (Two internal exams will be conducted in a semester and the best mark will be considered for internal)

#### ***Internal Mark division for practical***

- 5 Marks for attendance
- 5 Marks for performance
- 5 Marks for test
- 5 Marks for record

### **Attendance Weightage for each subject (Theory & Practical)**

The weightage shall be on the basis of subject attendance
